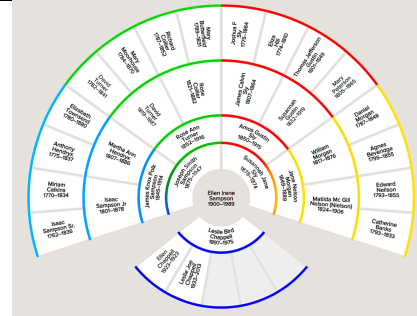


Goal #2 - Where Do I Start?

Step 1 - Make sure that you have validated a real connection back to 2nd or 3rd generation great grandparents!! Remember that if they were incorrectly attached to your tree, you will not be doing descendency research on YOUR line.

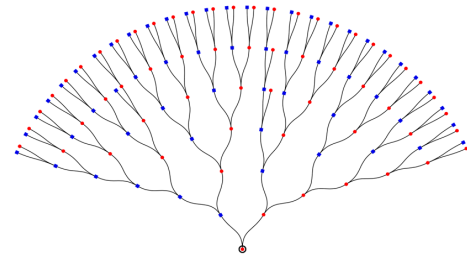
Step 2 - Search for an ancestor that was born in the early 1800s

Fan Charts - These easily allow one to view all their direct line ancestors. It is a graphical representation of what is in Family Tree. In other words, if there are no ancestors in Family Tree, there will be large holes in your chart.

Puzzilla.org - This is a website that reads your Family Tree data and then graphically displays an ancestor chart using "dots & lines". Each dot represents an individual. Hovering your mouse over the dot (person), brings up that specific individual's facts. Clicking on the interactive dot, will allow you to view the ancestors OR descendants of that person, or to go to that person in Family Tree.

BYU Virtual Pedigree - This is a fairly new web based app that also uses your Family Tree data to create an interactive tree that allows you to move with ease through your tree.
