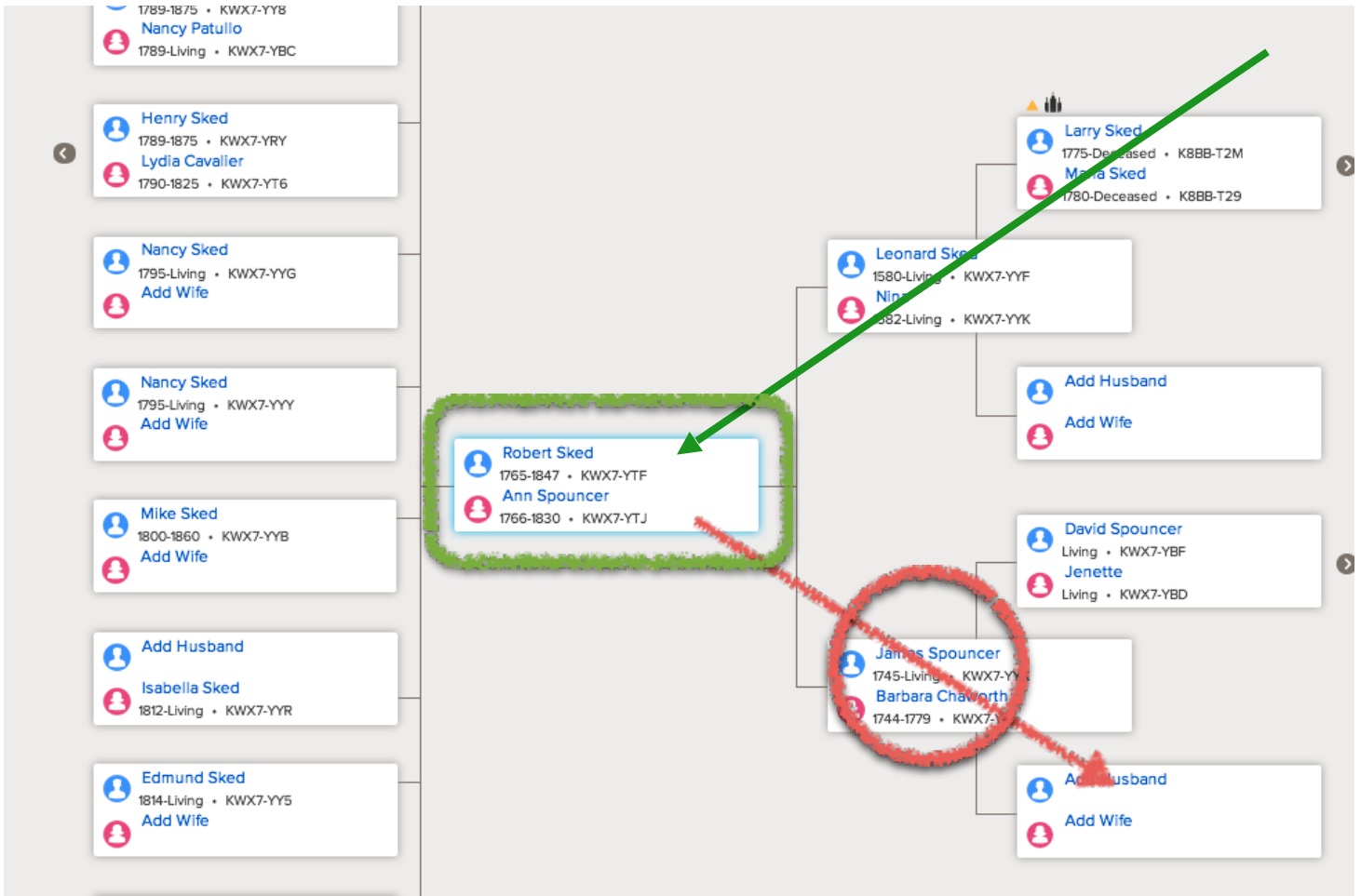


Descendancy Research and Temple Work



Do the temple work **ONLY** for YOUR **line of descendants**. Always work **DOWN** the pedigree, but **NEVER** loop backwards. For this example, Robert Sked is in your line of descendants. He marries Ann. Her temple work can be done, including be sealed to her parents, even if their work is not yet completed. When her parents have their work completed, and have accepted those ordinances, that sealing will become valid.

You shouldn't do her parents ordinances since they are not the direct descendant line. If you find a lot of information on Ann's parents and other families, you **MAY** enter in your researched information as a great missionary effort for her ancestors. It is just the **TEMPLE** work that will not be authorized to be done.
